

CHAPTER – 4

CIRCULATION OF PUBLICATIONS

4.1. A total number of 32,680 publications furnished their circulation figures online for 2019-20 (excluding ‘Miscellaneous’ publications) claiming a total circulation of 43,99,29,769 copies per publishing day as against 52,05,14,168 copies per publishing day in 2018-19, thereby registering a decrease of 15.48 percent over the previous year. (*Table 4.1*)

DAILIES

4.2.1. The number of Daily publications, which furnished circulation figures, has decreased from 10,167 publications in 2018-19 to 9,840 publications in 2019-20. The combined circulation of all Dailies was 25,84,22,000 copies per publishing day in 2019-20 as against 29,15,35,681 copies per publishing day in 2018-19, i.e., a decrease of 11.36 percent. (*Table 4.1 & 4.5*)

4.2.2. The number of Bi and Tri-weeklies, which furnished circulation figures, was 5,19,013 in 2019-20. (*Table 4.1 & 4.5*)

PERIODICALS

4.3. Among Periodicals, Dailies had a combined share of 25,84,22,000 copies per publishing day, i.e. 58.74 percent of the total circulation, followed by Weeklies with 10,72,63,381 copies per publishing day, i.e., 24.38 percent of total circulation. The Monthlies, with a total circulation of 4,68,83,382 copies per publishing day or 10.65 percent of total circulation, was at the third place. (*Table 4.2*)

LANGUAGE-WISE CIRCULATION

4.4.1. In 2019-20, Hindi publications retained their largest share in claimed circulation with 20,14,33,695 copies per publishing day or 45.78 percent of the total circulation, followed by English publications with 5,32,08,297 copies per publishing day (12.09%). Other languages in which publications had claimed circulation of more than ten million copies were Marathi - 3,47,59,281 (7.90%); Telugu - 2,75,64,658 (6.26 %); Urdu - 2,62,41,593 (5.96%); Gujarati - 2,18,56,199 (4.96%); and Malayalam - 1,39,40,643 (3.16%). (*Table 4.2*)

4.4.2. Even among Dailies, Hindi publications maintained their top position with a claimed circulation of 11,48,55,520 copies per publishing day, or to say 44.44 percent of the total claimed circulation of all daily publications. The English Dailies claimed second position with a circulation of 2,97,89,705 copies per publishing day (11.52%). The Dailies published in other languages were Marathi - 2,31,91,951; Urdu - 2,15,10,915; Telugu - 1,77,74,215; Gujarati - 1,09,96,574; Malayalam - 82,35,250; Tamil - 53,51,085; Kannada - 74,58,278; Odia - 63,32,326; and Bengali - 39,91,521 copies per publishing day etc. (*Table 4.2*)

4.4.3. Among Periodicals, Hindi Dailies publications had the highest circulation of 11,48,55,520 copies per publishing day. Hindi Weekly publications claimed second position with a circulation of 5,59,58,087 copies per publishing day followed by English Dailies - 2,97,89,705; Marathi Dailies - 2,31,91,951; Urdu Dailies - 2,15,10,915; Hindi Monthly - 1,96,49,855; Telugu Dailies - 1,77,74,215; and English Weekly - 1,46,85,029 etc. (*Table 4.2*)

STATE-WISE CIRCULATION

4.5.1. The claimed circulation of publications was the highest in Uttar Pradesh with 7,39,46,739 copies per publishing day during 2019-20. Maharashtra came second with 5,95,54,816 copies per publishing day; Madhya Pradesh was third with 5,09,55,573 copies; and Delhi came fourth with 3,58,66,346 copies per publishing day. Other States with a circulation of more than ten million copies per publishing day were: Gujarat - 2,65,52,367 copies per publishing day; Andhra Pradesh - 2,26,52,398 copies per publishing day; Rajasthan - 1,96,71,464 copies per publishing day; Uttarakhand - 1,62,74,642 copies per publishing day; Kerala - 1,55,61,473 copies per publishing day; Tamil Nadu - 1,43,43,171 copies per publishing day; West Bengal - 1,38,56,359 copies per publishing day; Telangana - 1,37,64,432 copies per publishing day; Karnataka - 1,35,53,263 copies per publishing day; and Odisha - 1,23,22,856 copies per publishing day. (*Table 4.3*)

4.5.2. Uttar Pradesh had the maximum claimed circulation of Daily publications with 4,01,96,803 copies per publishing day followed by Maharashtra 3,59,63,238 copies per publishing day; Madhya Pradesh - 2,88,51,629 copies per publishing day; Delhi - 1,81,73,254 copies per publishing day; Andhra Pradesh - 1,49,39,282 copies per publishing day; Gujarat - 1,41,29,068 copies per publishing day; and Rajasthan - 1,34,73,126 copies per publishing day. (*Table 4.3*)

4.5.3. The minimum circulation was found in the UT of Ladakh numbering 1000 only. (*Table 4.3*)

4.5.4. The claimed circulation of weeklies in 2019-20 was the highest in Uttar Pradesh with 2,64,64,489 copies per publishing day followed by Maharashtra 1,80,43,957 copies per publishing day; Madhya Pradesh - 1,19,81,388 copies per publishing day; Uttarakhand - 93,34,021 copies per publishing day; Delhi - 89,32,000 copies per publishing day; Gujarat - 81,74,381 copies per publishing day; West Bengal - 33,64,100 copies per publishing day; Tamil Nadu - 26,46,757 copies per publishing day; Odisha - 25,15,707 copies per publishing day; Kerala - 23,16,107 copies per publishing day; and Rajasthan - 21,14,877 copies per publishing day etc. (*Table 4.3*)

4.5.5. In the claimed circulation of fortnightlies in 2019-20, Rajasthan occupied the first position with 30,05,499 copies per publishing day followed by Delhi with 24,28,024 copies per publishing day; Uttar Pradesh - 18,79,098 copies per publishing day; Gujarat - 18,56,482 copies per publishing day; Maharashtra - 18,53,020 copies per publishing day; West Bengal - 16,19,777 copies per publishing day; Uttarakhand- 15,30,792 copies per publishing day; Kerala - 12,30,084 copies per publishing day; Andhra Pradesh - 11,64,092 copies per publishing day; Madhya Pradesh - 11,06,368 copies per publishing day; and Odisha - 11,05,290 copies per publishing day. These were the only States having a total circulation of over one million copies per publishing day each in 2019-20. (*Table 4.3*)

4.5.6. Among Monthly publications, Madhya Pradesh claimed largest circulation with 83,48,114 copies per publishing day; followed by Delhi - 55,83,513 copies per publishing day; Andhra Pradesh - 50,70,808 copies per publishing day; Uttar Pradesh -

47,13,714 copies per publishing day; Tamil Nadu - 33,66,166 copies per publishing day; Kerala - 29,18,844 copies per publishing day; Telangana - 27,89,915 copies per publishing day; Maharashtra - 26,34,922 copies per publishing day; Gujarat - 22,63,640 copies per publishing day; Odisha - 13,58,006 copies per publishing day; Karnataka - 13,55,559 copies per publishing day; Uttarakhand - 11,13,588 copies per publishing day; and Rajasthan - 10,46,093 copies per publishing day. (*Table 4.3*)

LANGUAGE-CUM STATE-WISE CIRCULATION

4.6. Language-wise analysis of claimed circulation of publications for 2019-20 reveals that Uttar Pradesh was at the top with 5,90,10,144 copies per publishing day in Hindi language, i.e., 29.30 percent of total circulation of Hindi Language; followed by Madhya Pradesh - 4,82,14,713 copies; Rajasthan - 1,87,24,013 copies per publishing day; Delhi - 1,85,02,581 copies per publishing day; and Uttarakhand - 1,45,32,633 copies per publishing day. The total circulation of English Language publications was 5,32,08,297 copies per publishing day, out of which Maharashtra accounted for 1,14,62,909 copies per publishing day, i.e., 21.54 percent of the total circulation in English followed by Delhi - 1,08,92,632 copies per publishing day (20.47 %) and Jammu & Kashmir - 36,00,178 copies per publishing day (6.76 %). The total circulation of Gujarati publications was 2,18,56,199 copies per publishing day out of which Gujarat accounted for 2,08,72,427 copies per publishing day, i.e., (95.49 %). The total circulation of Telugu publications was 2,75,64,658 copies out of which Andhra Pradesh accounted for 1,82,70,176 copies per publishing day. The total circulation of Marathi publications was 3,47,59,281 copies per publishing day, out of which Maharashtra accounted for 3,41,28,167 copies per publishing day, i.e., (98.18 %). The total circulation of Urdu publications was 2,62,41,593 copies per publishing day, out of which Uttar Pradesh accounted for 1,03,10,704 copies per publishing day, i.e., (39.29 %). (*Table 4.4*)

DISTRIBUTION PATTERN

4.7.1. Out of 43,99,29,769 copies circulated per publishing day in 2019-20, as many as 41,69,92,851 copies per publishing day (94.78 %) were sold and 2,29,36,918 copies per publishing day (5.21 %) were distributed free, which included samples, vouchers, complimentary and office copies. (*Table 4.5*)

4.7.2. In case of daily newspapers, out of a total claimed circulation of 25,84,22,000 copies per publishing day, the number of copies sold per publishing day were 24,95,41,334 (96.56 %) and free copies were 88,80,666 (3.43 %). (*Table 4.5*)

CIRCULATION PATTERN

4.8.1. A total of 32,680 publications submitted their Annual Statements and supplied their circulation data within stipulated filing period. Based on their circulation figures, the newspapers have been classified into following three categories:

- (i) **Small:** Circulation up to 25,000 copies per publishing day,
- (ii) **Medium:** Circulation between 25,001 to 75,000 copies per publishing day,
- (iii) **Big:** Circulation of more than 75,000 copies per publishing day,
- (iv) **Others:** Zero or 'NIL' Circulation figure.

4.8.2. Out of 32,680 newspapers and periodicals which supplied their circulation data, 811, i.e., 2.48 percent fall in the ‘Big’ category; 2,566, i.e., 7.85 percent in the ‘Medium’ category, 58 in the ‘Others’ category, i.e., 0.17 percent and remaining 29,245, i.e., 89.48 percent in the ‘Small’ category. Publications falling in the ‘Small’ category have the largest share in the circulation with 19,35,19,071 copies per publishing day, i.e., 43.98 percent of total, followed by the ‘Big’ category with 14,69,56,285 copies per publishing day, i.e., 33.40 percent and the ‘Medium’ category having 9,94,54,413 copies per publishing day, i.e., 22.60 percent. (*Table 4.6 & 4.7*)

4.8.3. The ‘Big’ category is further divided into two sub-categories – those having a circulation between (i) 1,00,000 to 25,00,000 copies per publishing day; and (ii) 75,001 to 99,999 copies per publishing day. In the first sub-category, there are 579 publications with a total circulation of 12,71,43,330 copies per publishing day, whereas in the second, there are 232 publications, with a total circulation of 1,98,12,955 copies per publishing day. (*Table 4.6*)

4.8.4. The ‘Medium’ category of publications is also classified into two sub-categories – viz., (i) 25,001 to 50,000 copies; and (ii) 50,001 to 75,000 copies. In the first sub-category, there are 2,168 publications with a total circulation of 7,52,85,340 copies per publishing day and in the second, there are 398 publications with a total circulation of 2,41,69,073 copies per publishing day. (*Table 4.6*)

4.8.5. The publications falling under the ‘Small’ category can be divided into four sub-categories according to their circulation figures, viz (i) 15,001 to 25,000 copies; (ii) 5,001 to 15,000 copies; (iii) 2,001 to 5,000 copies; and (iv) 1 to 2,000 copies. It has been noticed that 4,757 had the circulation range between 15,001 and 25,000; 10,054 had the circulation range between 5,001 and 15,000; 4,873 had the circulation range between 2,001 and 5,000; and 9,561 had the circulation range between 1 and 2000. (*Table 4.6*)

4.8.6. Publications falling under the ‘Others’ category are based on the Annual Statements filed by publishers, irrespective of language or periodicity, in which the circulation figure has been provided as ‘0’ or ‘Nil’. There are a total of 58 such publications in the period 2019-20. (*Table 4.6*)

4.8.7. Out of the 9,877 dailies and Bi and Tri-weeklies that filed circulation data for the year 2019-20, 648 came under the ‘Big’ category, 1,843 under ‘Medium’ category, 2 came under the ‘Others’ category and the remaining 7,384 were ‘Small’ newspapers. Out of 648 ‘Big’ Dailies/Tri and Bi-weeklies, 465 had a circulation of one lakh and above each. (*Table 4.6 and 4.7*)

4.8.8. As regards to Dailies and Bi and Tri-weeklies and other periodicals, the largest circulation was of ‘Small’ newspapers (19,35,19,071), i.e., 43.98 percent, followed by ‘Big’ newspapers (14,69,56,285), i.e., 33.40 percent and ‘Medium’ newspapers (9,94,54,413), i.e., 22.60 percent. (*Table 4.7*)

4.8.9. A significant section of newspapers and periodicals, particularly the ‘Small’ publications, appears to ignore its obligations to submit the Annual Statements to the O/o RNI under Section 19(D) of the “Press and Registration of Books Act 1867”. Their circulation, therefore, could not be ascertained and hence the actual circulation of the registered Indian publications would be much higher than what this report projects on the basis of Annual Statements actually received.

AVERAGE CIRCULATION

4.9.1. The average circulation of Dailies and Tri/Bi-weeklies was 26,216 copies per publishing day where as the average circulation of the other periodicals were 7937 copies per publishing day during 2019-20. Average circulation of Big newspapers decreased by 18,459 copies - from 1,98,168 to 1,79,709 copies per publishing day during 2019-20 and that of Small newspapers increased by 811 copies - from 8,687 to 9,498 copies per publishing day during 2019-20. As for the Medium newspapers, the average circulation increased by 1202 copies per publishing day - from 38,054 to 39256 during 2019-20 in comparison to the previous year. (*Table 4.7*)

4.9.2. The average circulation of Dailies and Tri/Bi-weeklies showed a decrease of 2,462 copies per publishing day, i.e., from 28,678 to 26,216 copies per publishing day in 2019-20. (*Table 4.7*)

4.9.3. The average circulation of periodicals also showed a decrease of 469 copies per publishing day, i.e., from 8,406 to 7,937 copies per publishing day in 2019-20. (*Table 4.7*)

CENTRE-WISE CIRCULATION

4.10.1. The publications brought out from the 13 Metropolitan Cities had a combined claimed circulation of 9,33,50,368 copies per publishing day in 2019-20. The State Capitals accounted for 14,97,82,727 copies per publishing day. The publications brought out from Big Cities claimed a total circulation of 27,80,21,292 copies per publishing day. The Press in the Union Territories accounted for 3,69,61,001 copies per publishing day. The remaining 1,08,36,787 copies per publishing day belonged to Smaller Towns. (*Table 4.8*)

4.10.2. The Dailies and Tri/Bi-weeklies from 13 Metropolitan Cities had a total circulation of 6,59,90,059 copies per publishing day. The Dailies and Tri/Bi-weeklies published from State Capitals had a total circulation of 10,04,49,047 copies per publishing day. The Dailies and Tri/Bi-weeklies from other Big Cities claimed a total circulation of 19,87,60,491 copies per publishing day and from the Smaller Towns, it showed a circulation of 78,85,512 copies per publishing day. (*Table 4.8*)

CIRCULATION LEVELS

4.11.1. “*Anand Bazar Patrika*”, a Bengali/Daily published from Kolkata was the largest circulated single edition daily with a claimed circulation of 10,72,342 copies per publishing day followed by “*Hindustan Times*”, a English/Daily published from Delhi with a claimed circulation of 8,95,982 copies per publishing day.
