

CHAPTER – 3

PUBLICATIONS WHICH FILED ANNUAL STATEMENT FOR 2018-19

3.1. Under Section 19(D) of the PRB Act, 1867, it is mandatory for every registered publication to submit an Annual Statement to the Office of the Registrar of Newspapers for India. The Annual Statements are the principal source of data for compilation of the Annual Report of the Registrar of Newspapers for India called “PRESS IN INDIA”. RNI has taken steps to facilitate the process of filing of the annual statements by the publishers and an online system of e-filing of Annual Statements has been put in place on our website. However, it is observed that not all the publishers are submitting their Annual Statements. Non-compliance with the above provision of the Act by publishers has so far precluded this office from claiming this report to be a comprehensive data bank of the print media in India. However, in order to make this report a more meaningful document with authentic statistical information, the Annual Statements received from the publishers online for the year 2018-19 have only been taken into account in this chapter. Out of 1,19,995 registered newspapers & periodicals as many as 37,942 submitted their Annual Statements including 532 publications of Miscellaneous classification. The chapter depicts a general trend in the Print Media in the country on the basis of various parameters such as – Periodicity, Language, State, City, Town etc.

DAILIES

3.2.1. During the year 2018-19, as many as 10,167 daily publications submitted their Annual Statements. These were being brought out in all the languages listed in the Eighth Schedule of the Indian Constitution. Among the dailies, Hindi retained its top position in the list with 4,333 Dailies while other languages with more than 200 Dailies are (i) Urdu (1,231) (ii) Telugu (1,196), (iii) English (897), (iv) Marathi (629), (v) Kannada (540) and (vi) Gujarati (442). (Table 3.1)

PERIODICALS

3.3. A total number of 27,243 publications of various periodicities (except Dailies) submitted their Annual Statements for 2018-19. Out of these, 12,742 were Weeklies; 9,021 Monthlies; 3,435 Fortnightlies; 865 Quarterlies and 147 Annuals. There are 1,033 periodicals i.e. Bi-monthly, Half-yearly etc., which are categorized as other periodicities. Weeklies and Monthlies with their total number at 21,762 appeared to be more popular, accounting for nearly 58.18 per cent approx of the total periodicals. (Table 3.1)

LANGUAGE-WISE ANALYSIS

3.4.1. As per the circulation data available, publications were brought out in 45 languages and dialects in 2018-19. Apart from English and other principal languages, listed in the Eighth Schedule of the Indian Constitution, publications were also published in 22 other

languages or dialects mostly Indian and a few foreign languages. Other languages in which publications came out were - Ao Naga, Arabic, Bhojpuri, Chhattisgarhi, Sindhi Devnagri, Garo, Garhwali, Halbi, Karbi, Khasi, Khortha, Kharia, Kokborok, Meeteilon, Mizo Lushai, Naga, Nagpuri, Rajasthani, Santhali, Tenyidie and Tulu.

3.4.2. Among the publications of different languages which submitted their Annual Statements during 2018-19, the highest number of publications were in Hindi (18,109) followed by English (3,044), Marathi (2,916), Telugu (2,603), Gujarati (2,270), Urdu (1,932), Kannada (1,242), Tamil (920), Bengali (650), Odia (511) and Malayalam (457) etc. (Table 3.1)

3.4.3. Apart from publications brought out in one language, there were also quite a number of publications which were brought out in two or more languages in the same issue. Such publications were categorized as 'Bi-lingual' and 'Multi-lingual'. There were 2,003 'Bilingual' and 274 'Multilingual' publications in the country.

STATE-WISE ANALYSIS

3.5.1. Uttar Pradesh with 6,603 publications filing their online Annual Statements in 2018-19 retained its top position among the States. Madhya Pradesh with (5,833) publications came next followed by Maharashtra (4,574); Delhi (2,702); Andhra Pradesh (2,533); Gujarat (2,525); Rajasthan (1,993) and Uttarakhand(1,938). Other States from where more than 300 publications filed their online Annual Statements were Uttarakhand (1,938); Karnataka (1,499); Telangana (839); West Bengal (830); Odisha (633); Kerala (611); Chhattisgarh (582); J & K (458); Haryana (396); Punjab (366) and Bihar (346). (Table 3.2)

3.5.2. In the category of Dailies also, Uttar Pradesh maintained its lead with 2,204 Daily publications followed by Andhra Pradesh (1,181); Madhya Pradesh (1,180); Maharashtra (882); Delhi (631); Karnataka (615) and Gujarat (549). Daily newspapers were published from all the States and Union Territories. (Table 3.2)

3.5.3. About 58.18 per cent of the periodicals being published were either Weeklies or Monthlies. Out of 27,243 periodicals (except Dailies), about 46.77 per cent were held by Weeklies only. The largest number of Weeklies were being published from Uttar Pradesh (2,997); followed by Maharashtra (2,444); Madhya Pradesh (1,788); Uttarakhand (1,290); Gujarat (1,244); Delhi (615) and Rajasthan (416). (Table 3.2)

3.5.4. About 24.12 per cent of the total number of periodicals being published were Monthlies. The largest number of Monthlies were published from Madhya Pradesh (2,260) followed by Delhi (928); Andhra Pradesh (848); Uttar Pradesh (837) and Tamil Nadu (715). Other states publishing more than 200 monthlies were Maharashtra (708); Karnataka (407); Gujarat (364); Kerala (308); Telangana (253); Rajasthan (252) and West Bengal (202). (Table 3.2)

3.5.5. Maharashtra brought out publications in 19 languages followed by Delhi in 18, Uttarakhand in 17 languages, Tamil Nadu in 17 languages, Kerala in 17 languages, Gujarat and Karnataka in 15 languages each, West Bengal in 14 languages, Punjab in 11 languages,

Rajasthan and Uttar Pradesh in 11 languages each, Andhra Pradesh and Puducherry in 10 languages, Assam, Bihar in 9 languages, each out of 24 main languages (excluding English) listed in the Eighth Schedule of the Indian Constitution). (Table 3.3)

3.5.6. The distinction for bringing out the highest number of publications in a single language went to Madhya Pradesh, where 5,429 publications were brought out in Hindi. The other States with over 500 publications in Hindi were Uttar Pradesh (5,246); Rajasthan (1,789); Uttarakhand (1,757); and Delhi (1,446). (Table 3.3)

3.5.7. States with more than 200 publications in a single language were (i) Delhi (Hindi 1,446) and (English 617); (ii) Andhra Pradesh (Telugu 2,084); (iii) Gujarat (Gujarati 2,170); (iv) Maharashtra (Marathi 2,862), (Hindi 613) and English (491); (v) Uttar Pradesh (Hindi 5,246) and Urdu (852); (vi) West Bengal (Bengali 561); (vii) Tamil Nadu (Tamil 848); (viii) Odisha (Odia 493); (ix) Kerala (Malayalam 431); (x) Karnataka (Kannada 1,213); (xi) Chhattisgarh (Hindi 536); (xii) Haryana (Hindi 320); (xiii) Madhya Pradesh (Hindi 5,429); (xiv) Telangana (Telugu 486); (xv) Uttarakhand (Hindi 1,757); (xvi) Rajasthan (Hindi 1,789) (Table 3.3)

CONCENTRATION

3.6. The Print Media tends to concentrate in certain important Cities and Towns, giving them prominence as major printing and publishing centers, which can be classified as under:

- (vi) Metropolitan Cities (Delhi, Kolkata, Mumbai and Chennai),
- (vii) State Capitals (other than the Metropolitan Cities),
- (viii) Union Territories,
- (ix) Big Cities, (having a population of more than 1,00,000), and
- (x) Small Towns. (having a population of less than 1,00,000)

LANGUAGE-WISE ANALYSIS

3.7. Among those publications, which submitted their Annual Statements online during 2018-19, Language wise analysis of publications shows that out of 18,109 Hindi publications, 7,526 were brought out from the State Capitals; 6,505 from the Big Cities and 2,285 from the Smaller Towns. Out of 3,043 publications in English, 1,113 were brought out from the four Metropolitan Cities. The other languages in which a large number of publications came out from the Metropolitan Cities were Hindi (1,668); English (1,114); Tamil (422), Marathi (285) and Urdu (253). The four metropolitan cities published 449 Bilingual and 50 Multilingual publications. (Table 3.4)

NUMERICAL ANALYSIS

3.8.1. The total number of publications brought out from the four metropolitan cities during 2018-19 was 4,607 accounting for 12.31 per cent of the total publications. State Capitals (excluding the Metropolitan Cities) published 11,837 publications constituting 31.64 per cent of the total. Big cities published a total of 16,171 publications constituting 43.23 per cent. Thus the Big cities dominated the number of publications in India in 2018-19. A total of 4,439 publications came out from Small Towns and 90 from Union Territories. (Table 3.5)

3.8.2. Out of 10,167 Dailies, a total of 927 were being published from the Metropolitan Cities and 3,069 from the State Capitals. The Big Cities in various States published 4,766 Dailies and Small Towns brought out 1,270 Daily Newspapers. The Union Territories published only 137 Dailies. (Table 3.5)
