CHAPTER – 3 PUBLICATIONS WHICH FILED ANNUAL STATEMENT FOR 2016-17

3.1. Under Section 19(D) of the PRB Act, 1867, it is mandatory for every registered publication to submit an Annual Statement to the Office of the Registrar of Newspapers for India. The Annual Statements sent by them are the principal source of data for compilation of the Annual Report of the Registrar of Newspapers for India called "PRESS IN INDIA" The RNI has taken steps to facilitate the process of filing of the annual statements by the publishers and an online system of e-filing of Annual Statements put in place in our website. However, it is observed that not all the publishers are submitting their Annual Statements. Non-compliance with the above provision of the Act by publishers has so far precluded this office from claiming this report to be a comprehensive data bank of the print media in India. However, in order to make this report a more meaningful document with authentic statistical information, the Annual Statements received from the publishers online for the year 2016-17 have only been taken into account in this chapter. Out of 1,14,820 registered newspapers & periodicals as many as 29,556 submitted their Annual Reports online. The chapter gives a general trend in the Print Media in the country on the basis of various parameters such as – Periodicity-wise, Language-wise, State-wise, City-wise, Small Town-wise, etc.

DAILIES

3.2.1. During the year 2016-17, as many as 9,061 daily publications submitted their Annual Statements. These were being brought out in all the languages listed in the Eighth Schedule of the Indian Constitution except Bodo. Among the dailies, Hindi retained its top position in the list with 3,996 Dailies while other languages with more than 200 Dailies are (i) Urdu (1,236) (ii) Telugu (935), (iii) English (830), (iv) Marathi (509) and (v) Gujarati (420). (Table 3.1)

PERIODICALS

3.3. A total number of 20,495 publications of various periodicities (except Dailies) submitted their Annual Statements for 2016-17. Out of these, 10,638 were Weeklies; 5,788 Monthlies; 2,804 Fortnightlies; 446 Quarterlies and 96 Annuals. There are 723 periodicals i.e. Bi-monthly, Half-yearly etc., which are categorized as other periodicities. The Weeklies and Monthlies with their total number at 16,426 appeared to be more popular, accounting for nearly 55.58 per cent of the total periodicals. (Table 3.1)

LANGUAGE-WISE ANALYSIS

3.4.1. As per the circulation data available, publications were brought out in 49 languages and dialects in 2016-17. Apart from English and other principal languages, listed in the Eighth Schedule of the Indian Constitution, publications were also published in 26 other languages or dialects mostly Indian and a few foreign languages. Other languages in which publications came out were Africans, Arabic, Bhojpuri, Braille, Chhattisgarhi Sindhi

Devnagri, Garo, Garhwali, German, Halbi, Hmar, Karbi, Khasi, Khortha, Kharia, Kokborok, Meeteilon, Mizo Lushai, Naga, Nagpuri, Rajasthani, Santhali, Tenyidie and Tulu.

3.4.2. Among the publications of different languages which submitted their Annual Statements during 2016-17, the highest number of publications were in Hindi (15,596) followed by English (2,317), Marathi (1,933), Urdu (1,879), Telugu (1,874), Gujarati (1,829), Kannada (741), Bengali (455), Odia (408), Tamil (384), and Malayalam (318) etc. (Table 3.1)

3.4.3. Apart from publications brought out in one language, there were also quite a number of publications which were brought out in two or more languages in the same issue. Such publications were categorized as 'Bi-lingual' and 'Multi-lingual'. There were 1,328 'Bilingual' and 143 'Multilingual' in the country.

STATE-WISE ANALYSIS

3.5.1. Uttar Pradesh with 6,023 publications filing their online Annual Statements in 2016-17 retained its top position among the states. Madhya Pradesh with (4,388) publications came next followed by Maharashtra (2,958); Delhi (2,405); Gujarat (2,001); Uttarakhand (1,999); Rajasthan (1,850); and Andhra Pradesh (1,757). Other States from where more than 300 publications filed their online Annual Statements were Karnataka (916); Telangana (763); West Bengal (586); Tamil Nadu (578); Odisha (515); Chhattisgarh (424); J & K (409); Kerala (389); Bihar (323); and Haryana (310). (Table 3.2)

3.5.2. In the category of Dailies also, Uttar Pradesh maintained its lead with 2,157 daily publications followed by Andhra Pradesh (882); Madhya Pradesh (866); Maharashtra (710); Delhi (645); Gujarat (510); and Karnataka (449); Daily newspapers were published from almost all the States and Union Territories except Lakshadweep. (Table 3.2)

3.5.3. About 55.58 per cent of the periodicals being published were either Weeklies or Monthlies. Out of 20,495 periodicals (except Dailies), about 51.91 per cent were held by Weeklies only. The largest number of Weeklies were being published from Uttar Pradesh (2,777); followed by Maharashtra (1,585); Madhya Pradesh (1,441); Uttarakhand (1,349); Gujarat (1,032); Delhi (613) and Rajasthan (444). (Table 3.2)

3.5.4. About 19.58 per cent of the total number of periodicals being published were Monthlies. The largest number of Monthlies were published from Madhya Pradesh (1,687) followed by Delhi (722723 Uttar Pradesh (614); Andhra Pradesh (523) and Maharashtra (354). Other states publishing more than 150 monthlies were Tamil Nadu (205); Telangana (195); Karnataka (193); Gujarat and Rajasthan (181 each); Uttarakhand (174); and Kerala (168) (Table 3.2)

3.5.5. Delhi brought out publications in 17 languages followed by Maharashtra in 16 languages, Karnataka and Uttarakhand in 12 languages each, Gujarat and West Bengal in 11 languages each, Andhra Pradesh and Puducherry in 10 languages each out of 22 main languages (excluding English) listed in the Eighth Schedule of the Indian Constitution). (Table 3.3)

3.5.6. The distinction for bringing out the highest number of publications in a single language went to Uttar Pradesh, where 4,763 publications were brought out in Hindi. The other States with over 500 publications in Hindi were Madhya Pradesh (4,109); Uttarakhand (1,820); Rajasthan (1,670) and Delhi (1,353). (Table 3.3)

3.5.7. States with more than 200 publications in a single language were (i) Delhi (Hindi 1,353), (English 510) and Urdu (224); (ii) Andhra Pradesh (Telugu 1,421); (iii) Gujarat (Gujarati 1,765); (iv) Maharashtra (Marathi 1,898), (Hindi 443) and English (271); (v) Uttar Pradesh (Hindi 4,763) and Urdu (843); (vi) West Bengal (Bengali 378); (vii) Tamil Nadu (Tamil 342); (viii) Odisha (Odia 402); (ix) Kerala (Malayalam 301); (x) Karnataka (Kannada 726); (xi) Chhattisgarh (Hindi 390); (xii) Haryana (Hindi 254); (xiii) Madhya Pradesh (Hindi 4,109); (xiv) Telangana (Telugu 438); (xv) Uttarakhand (Hindi 1,820); (xvi) Rajasthan (Hindi 1,670) (Table 3.3)

CONCENTRATION

3.6. The Print Media tends to concentrate in certain important Cities and Towns, giving them prominence as major printing and publishing centers, which can be classified as under:

- (i) Metropolitan Cities (Delhi, Kolkata, Mumbai and Chennai),
- (ii) State Capitals (other than the Metropolitan Cities),
- (iii) Union Territories,
- (iv) Big Cities, (having a population of more than 1,00,000), and
- (v) Small Towns. (having a population of less than 1,00,000)

LANGUAGE-WISE ANALYSIS

3.7. Among those publications, which submitted their Annual Statements online during 2016-17, Language wise analysis of publications shows that out of 15,596 Hindi publications, 6,443 were brought out from the State Capitals; 5,446 from the Big Cities and 2,091 from the Smaller Towns. Out of 2,317 publications in English, 843 were brought out from the four Metropolitan Cities. The other languages in which a large number of publications came out from the Metropolitan Cities were Hindi (1,551); English (843), Urdu (264); and Marathi (175). The four metropolitan cities published 313 Bilingual and 19 Multilingual publications. (Table3.4)

NUMERICAL ANALYSIS

3.8.1. The total number of publications brought out from the four metropolitan cities during 2016-17 was 3,547 accounting for 12 per cent of the total publications. State Capitals (excluding the Metropolitan Cities) published 9,761 publications constituting 33.03 per cent of the total. Big cities published a total of 12,267 publications constituting 41.50 per cent. Thus the Big cities dominated the number of publications in India in 2016-17. A total of 3,768 publications came out from Small Towns and 213 from Union Territory. (Table 3.5)

3.8.2. Out of 9,061 dailies, a total of 899 were being published from the Metropolitan Cities and 2,764 from the State Capitals. The Big Cities in various States published 4,112 Dailies and Small Towns brought out 1,189 Daily newspapers. The Union Territories published only 105 Dailies. (Table 3.5)
