CHAPTER - 9

PRESS IN STATES AND UNION TERRITORIES

- **9.1.1.** The Indian Press spread over 28 States and 8 Union Territories, has shown upward trend in terms of registered publications, both at National as well as Regional levels. This plays a significant role in national as well as regional print media, which is evident from the statistical data collected over the years.
- **9.1.2.** The Annual Statements received online from the publishers for 2021-22 indicate that Uttar Pradesh retained the top position in filing Annual Statements with 6,051 publications (Newspapers & Periodicals). Madhya Pradesh came second with 5,620 and Maharashtra third with 4,278 publications (Newspapers & Periodicals). *(Chapter 3, Table 3.2)*
- **9.1.3.** The total number of registered publications (Newspapers & Periodicals) went up to 1,46,045in all the States and Union Territories except Lakshadweep during the year under review.
- **9.1.4.** As far as the registered publications are concerned, Uttar Pradesh continued to be the largest publisher with 21,336publications (Newspapers & Periodicals) followed by Maharashtra 20,098 and Delhi 16,398. (*Chapter 2, Table 2.4*)
- **9.1.5.** Odisha brought out publications in 22 languages each followed by Maharashtra and Delhi 18 languages; Tamil Nadu 16, West Bengal in 15 languages; Karnataka and Uttarakhand in 14 languages; Andhra Pradesh, Maharashtra, Uttar Pradesh and Telangana in 13 languages; Kerala in 12 languages; Punjab in 11 languages and Puducherry in 10 languages each; and Assam in 8 languages, out of 22 main languages (excluding English) listed in the Eighth Schedule of the Indian Constitution.
- **9.1.6** As many as33,927publications (Newspapers & Periodicals) filed their Annual Statements online for the year 2021-22, which represents a increase of 3.00 percent as compared to last year. Circulation-wise the press in Uttar Pradesh retained its top position with a combined circulation of 7,56,31,146copies, followed by Madhya Pradesh with 5,23,34,334 copies per publishing day and Maharashtra with 5,60,04,918.
- **9.1.7.** A list of 'Big', 'Medium' and 'Small' publications in each State and Union Territory with their claimed circulation is given in Appendix I. An analysis of the status of the Press in various States and Union Territories along with their circulation is given as under:

- **9.2.1**. Total number of registered publications were 112 comprising of 29 Dailies; 32 Weeklies; 29 Fortnightlies; 18 Monthlies; 3 Quarterlies; and 1 of Other Periodicities. *(Table 9.1a)*
- **9.2.2.** Out of total 112registered publications, only 23 publications filed their Annual Statements for 2021-22 comprising of 16 Dailies, 5 Weeklies, and 2 Fortnightly. *(Table 9.2b)*

Circulation

9.2.3 Total claimed circulation was 93,137 copies per publishing day. English Press remained the largest with 42,489 claimed copies followed by Hindi 32,446 copies. (*Table 9.2b*)

9.2.4 As per the Annual Statement filed by the publisher in 2021-22, "*Today Times*", an English Daily from Port Blair had a claimed circulation of 15,250 copies per publishing day

- **9.3.1.** A total number of 39 new publications were added during 2021-22. Thus, the total number of registered Newspapers & Periodicals has gone up to 5,837 comprising of 1,666 Dailies; 8 Tri-Biweeklies; 820 Weeklies; 624 Fortnightlies; 2,445 Monthlies; 116 Quarterlies; 36 Annuals; and 122 Other Periodicities. *(Table 9.2a)*
- **9.3.2.** Annual Statements were received from 1,985 publications, i.e., 934 Dailies; 182 Weeklies; 149 Fortnightlies; 695 Monthlies; 12 Quarterlies; 1 Annual; and 113 Others. *(Table 9.2b)*

Circulation

9.3.3. Data received from 1,985 publications claimed a total circulation of 1,75,41,651 copies per publishing day. Language-wise, Telugu publications had the major share in the total claimed circulation consisting of 1,41,95,213copies per publishing day. (*Table 9.2b*)

9.3.4 As per the Annual Statement filed by the publishers in 2021-22, "*Deccan Chronicle*, an English Daily from Secunderabad, had a claimed circulation of 4,52,524copies per publishing day.

- **9.5.1**. 2 new publications were registered during 2021-22. Thus, the number of total registered publications rose to 886 comprising of 160Dailies; 25 Tri-Bi-weeklies; 280 Weeklies; 97 Fortnightlies; 218 Monthlies; 49 Quarterlies; 24 Annuals; and 33 of Other Periodicities. *(Table 9.4a)*
- **9.5.2.** In Assam, out of 886 registered publications, as many as 130 publications filed their Annual Statements online in 2021-22. Among them, 65 were Dailies; 42 Weeklies; 2 Fortnightlies; 12 Monthlies; 1 Quarterly and 8 from Others. Language-wise, 60 Assamese publications filed Annual Statements, followed by 22 English, 19Bengali and 14 Hindi. *(Table 9.4b)*

Circulation

9.5.3. Annual Statements were submitted by 130 publications claiming a total circulation of 24,83,694 copies per publishing day. Dailies accounted for the large circulation with 14,40,204 copies per publishing day. Language-wise, Assamese Press was at the top with 10,92,288 copies per publishing day. (*Table 9.4b*)

9.5.4. As per the Annual Statement filed by the publishers in 2021-22, "*Sadin*" in Assamese language from Kamrup, had a claimed circulation 2,77,642 copies per publishing day.

- **9.6.1.** 8 new publications were added in the registration record of the State during 2021-22. Now, there are 2,191 registered publications in the state comprising of 588 Dailies; 28 Tri-Bi-weeklies; 737Weeklies; 194 Fortnightlies; 466 Monthlies; 117 Quarterlies; 8 Annuals; and 53 Others. (*Table 9.5a*)
- **9.6.2.** In Bihar, 259 registered publications submitted their Annual Statements online for 2021-22, including 185 Dailies. Among Periodicals, 25 were Weeklies; 38 Monthlies; 07 Fortnightlies and 4 Quarterlies. Language-wise, as many as 140 publications were brought out in Hindi followed by 99 in Urdu. (*Table 9.5b*)

Circulation

9.6.3. Circulation claimed by the 259 publications, accounted for 80,79,358 copies per publishing day in 2021-22. The share of Dailies was 74,30,849 copies followed by the Monthlies 3,52,358 copies per publishing day. The share of Hindi publication was 47,13,493 copies per publishing day. (*Table 9.5b*)

9.6.4. As per the Annual Statement filed by the publishers in 2021-22" Hindustan", a Hindi Daily from Patna, had a claimed circulation of 3,05,135 copies per publishing day.

- **9.7.1.** No new publication was registered in the UT of Chandigarh during 2021-22. The number of registered Newspapers & Periodicals in Chandigarh has, therefore, risen to 646 in 2021-22. These include 95 Dailies; 1 Tri-Bi-weekly; 161 Weeklies; 42 Fortnightlies; 235 Monthlies; 53 Quarterlies; 13 Annuals; and 46 of Other Periodicities. *(Table 9.6a)*
- **9.7.2.** Out of 646, only 81 publications from the UT Chandigarh submitted their Annual Statements for 2021-22. These were from 46 Dailies, 24 Weeklies, and 11Monthlies. Maximum number of publications were being brought out in Hindi and English (32) followed by Punjabi (10). (*Table 9.6b*)

Circulation

9.7.3. Total claimed circulation was 18,08,893 copies per publishing day. Dailies accounted for 13,93,229 copies per publishing day, followed by Weeklies 3,26,787. Language-wise, Hindi papers were at top with total circulation of 8,41,867 copies per publishing day followed by English with 6,31,106 copies per publishing day. (*Table 9.6b*)

9.7.4. As per the Annual Statement filed by the publishers in 2021-22, "*Jag Marg*", a Hindi Daily from Chandigarh, had a claimed circulation of 1,16,481copies per publishing day.

- **9.8.1.** 62 new publications were added in the list of registration record of the state during 2021-22. With this, the total number of Newspapers & Periodicals in the state has gone up to 1,816 comprising 347 Dailies; 1 Tri-Bi-weekly; 644 Weeklies; 122 Fortnightlies; 562 Monthlies; 99 Quarterlies; 10 Annuals; and 31 of Other Periodicities. *(Table 9.7a)*
- **9.8.2.** In total, 574 publications submitted their Annual Statements for 2021-22, i.e., 185 Dailies; 125 Weeklies; 31 Fortnightlies; 207 Monthlies; 15 Quarterlies; 3 Annual; and 8 Other Periodicities. Language-wise, 524 publications were published in Hindi, 10 in English, 5 in Urdu and 32 were in Bi-lingual. (*Table 9.7b*)

Circulation

9.8.3. The total circulation claimed by 574 publications was 65,16,035 copies per publishing day. Dailies were at the top with 47,02,325 copies per publishing day followed by Monthlies with 9,44,116 and weeklies with 7,02,362 copies per publishing day. Language-wise, Hindi press accounted for 61,39,957 copies per publishing day. (*Table 9.7b*)

Leading Newspapers

9.8.4. As per the Annual Statement filed by the publishers in 2021-22"*NAVBHARAT*" from Raipur a Hindi Daily, had a claimed circulation of 3,28,218copies per publishing day.

Language wise, Hindi and Urdu were on first and second position in filing Annual Statements with 4,860& 757 publications respectively. (*Table 9.34b*)

Circulation

9.35.3. The 6,051 publications, which submitted their Annual Statements had a combined circulation of 7,56,31,146 copies per publishing day during 2021-22. Dailies claimed a total circulation of 3,90,50,151 copies. Among periodicals, Weeklies were leading with a circulation of 2,80,91,519 copies per publishing day. Language-wise, Hindi newspapers had a circulation of 6,16,4,025 copies followed by Urdu with 1,00,47,750 copies per publishing day. (*Table 9.34b*)

- 9.37.1. In all, 13 new publications were registered during 2021-22 in West Bengal. The total number of registered Newspapers and Periodicals went up to 7,523 by the end of 2021-22. There were 379 Dailies; 35 Tri/Bi-weeklies; 1,322 Weeklies; 1,324 Fortnightlies; 2,396 Monthlies; 1,255 Quarterlies; 282 Annuals; and 530 with Other Periodicities. (*Table 9.36a*)
- **9.37.2.** As many as 674 Annual Statements were received from the publishers in West Bengal in 2021-22. These included 115 Dailies; 136 Weeklies; 213 Fortnightlies; 146 Monthlies; 34 Quarterlies; 5 Annuals; and 25 with Other Periodicities. *(Table 9.36b)*

Circulation

9.37.3. The above 674publishers had a combined circulation of 89,96,465 copies per publishing day during 2021-22. Among these, the share of Dailies was 43,34,014 copies, followed by Weeklies with 22,47,439copies per publishing day. Language-wise, Bengali publications maintained the highest total circulation with 61,07,273 copies, followed by English with 14,63,083 copies and Hindi with 8,27,952copies per publishing day.
